## **Inception of KLSN:**

Kolaghat Loke Siksha Niketan emerged as an NGO in the year 1985. Some devoted veteran social workers joined their hands, heads, hearts & minds with a few enthusiastic young persons with a noble mission of feeling urge to do some good to the poor and distressed people of Kolaghat, once a busy prosperous country business center on the bank of river Rupnarayan, now a dyeing rural harbor with a mixed community of cosmopolitan characters including the illiterate poor jobless fisherman, labors, rickshaw pullers, vegetable vendors, hawkers, tradesman as well as some educated and rich persons. The society consists of people of different castes and creed like Hindus, Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Jains, Buddhists etc and the poor and backward community of Scheduled Castes, Tribes like Santals and other backward castes. Most of the people had to struggle for earning square meal a day. These communities badly need their uplift and development.



## **How KLSN started its journey:**

Kolaghat Loke Siksha Niketan started its service by providing training to the women in tailoring, weaving and knitting and empowering them through micro financing and earning through self-employment. The eco-friendly jute bags with varieties of colors, designs, sizes and shapes produced by them and earned reputation from every nook and corners of the country. Their participation at the Trade fair at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi, training at National Institute of Fashion Technology, Calcutta, and National Council for Jute Diversification, New Delhi brought them into national limelight and bulk orders came from 'Arifed' of Assam Govt. and some other organizations. Later the plastic bags dominated the market and the market of jute bags slowly diminished. The artisans lost interest in the trade and found some other way for living. Still some skilled artisans trained by KLSN are earning through producing jute bags in a minor scale.

The Kolaghat Loke Siksha Niketan has been devoting services to the physically and mentally challenged children for their proper rehabilitation.

Establishing no poverty society in which people will be imbued with human values and lay foundation of fraternity and harmonious relationship and to save and make the planet congenial for the all creatures in the world.

- g. To arrange and organize lectures, seminars, conferences, discussions and study on problems facing in rural life and any other problems relevant to the objects of the society and publish reports, books, periodicals and leaflets for inter-change of experiences and ideas;
- h. To accept gifts, grant, donation, subscriptions or fees towards raising fund for the purpose of development of the society;
- i. To arrange for production, storing, repairing and construction for socioeconomic development of the life and to arrange and organize various trainings on tailoring, sewing work, needle work, knitting, fisheries, dairies and other small scale industries for self-employment of the general public;
- j. To open charitable dispensaries, children clinics, blood donation centers etc;
- k. To spread education, to imbibe moral consciousness and to help to promote universal brotherhood;
- l. To do all such other things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the attainment of the foregoing objects;
- m. The society will engage for importing improved technical/scientific education on rural technology to the traditional village artisans who are traditionally engaged in developing different crafts and working with local natural resources such training may also be given to other intending persons in the area. The institution thus developed will carry out research program for diversification of the natural resources and for product up gradation and value addition and also work to develop better utilization of agro resources for uplifting of rural economy;
- n. To established a “**Model Complete Rehabilitation Centre**” for all types of Disable person/s. Early childhood detection of Disability, their treatment and counseling and Education are main objective and our main target.

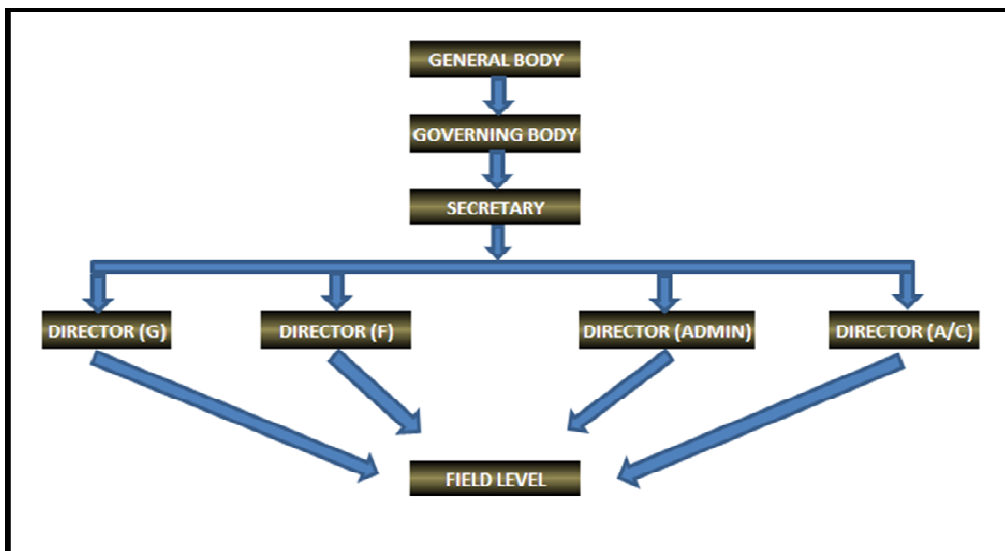
Programme area:
